Class Sequence for Handgun Courses

(Note the different levels reflect the proficiency and performance abilities that are expected. Therefore, each student must progress through a level to take classes in the next higher up level.)

Basic Level Classes (take in any order)

- Oklahoma SDA Class Handgun License Class (for Open or Concealed Carry)
- Carry 101
- NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Phase II (Phase 1 is an on line course at www.nrainstructors.org)

Intermediate Level

(Carry 101 and NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Phase I and II are required to advance to this level or proof of competence supplied by military or CLEET training. Other training will be considered.)

- Practical Pistol I
- NRA Basics of Personal Protection in the Home

<u>Proficient Level</u> (Intermediate level courses are required to take these classes.) (Completion of the courses in this level indicates a realistic and rigorous level of achievement indicating proficiency in knowledge, skills, and attitude in handling a firearm, accuracy, and self-defense with a firearm.

- Practical Pistol II
- NRA Personal Protection Outside the Home

<u>Advanced Level</u> (Proficient level courses are required to take these classes.) (Completion of classes in this level is a highly challenging and exemplary level of achievement indicating outstanding accomplishment in knowledge and handling of one's handgun.)

- Practical Pistol III
- Defensive Pistol
